Eligibility Criteria: Children and adults with a diagnosis of a serious emotional illness who are in need of support in accessing treatment or other services or in meeting essential needs.

Geographic Area Served:
We serve southeastern Erie County and northwestern Warren County.

Referral Process: The primary treatment provider is asked to complete a brief referral form.

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BLENDING CASE MANAGEMENT AT CORRY COUNSELING SERVICES

THE BCM PROGRAM

The goal of the Blended Case Management Program is to assist consumers in achieving recovery and meeting related goals.

The program offers a high level of support with in-home services, flexible services hours and on-call availability 24 hours a day.

Six core areas of service delivery to clients of the BCM program include assessment and service planning, informal support and network building, use of community resources, linking and accessing services, monitoring of service delivery, and problem resolution.

Services begin with an assessment of need in 8 realms of daily life and functioning. This is followed by the development of a service plan based on individual goals and assessed needs.

The Blended Case Management, or BCM, Program offers support to clients living with a mental health diagnosis in obtaining needed treatment and services and meeting individual goals.

HOW WE CAN ASSIST

- Linking and accessing mental health treatment services
- Obtaining medical care
- Exploring work and education
- Finding health insurance
- Obtaining needed benefits, such as disability
- Housing
- Service coordination
- Resolving disputes
- Identifying and overcoming barriers to independence
- Finding supports and opportunities for socialization in the community.

Length and frequency of services:

This varies depend on individual client and family need and the goals of service.

Hours of operation:

Staff work flexible hours in order to schedule sessions based on client need and availability. This includes evening and weekend hours.

Location of services:

Blended case managers deliver services to clients in their home, at the Corry Counseling office, and in a variety of community settings as necessary.

On-call availability:

The program offers on-call availability 24 hours a day.
